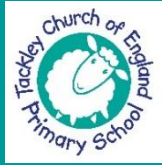


A Trip Down Memory Lane

Religious Education:

Areas of learning:

As **Scientists** we will be learning about growing up and how we are born as a baby and grow into a child and then an adult. We will be measuring our height and compare our height at the start of the term, against the end of the term. We will also be looking at the importance for human exercise, diet and hygiene.

As **Food Technologists** we will be looking at traditional family recipes and will be cooking up some treats to eat!

As **Artists** we will be following along our theme of memories and we will be creating collages. We will be using different types of materials such as magazines, felt, coloured paper, old photos and much more to represent a memory not to be forgotten!

As **Historians** we will be investigating changes within living memory. We will be studying British history from 1900 onwards and how events reveal aspects of change in British life. A study of old toys from the past will be making a prominent feature too.

As **Geographers** we will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, whilst we are exploring the changes in British life.

English:

As writers we will be looking at a range of genres such as narrative, instructions, poetry and explanatory texts. We will use fairy tales as a stimulus for our narratives and recipes as a purpose for our instruction writing.

In grammar we will be learning about different words types including nouns, adjectives and verbs. We will also look at contractions and the possessive apostrophe.

Maths

In maths we will be focusing on an array of mathematical areas including; number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, properties of shape, measurement, position and direction and fractions.

British Values:

Music:

As musicians we will explore beat through movement, body percussion and instruments. We will listen to and learn some old traditional songs.

Computing:

Physical Education:
