Absence - If your child is absent from school, please contact the school office before 9.30am and give an indication of the possible length of absence.

Meals & Snacks – At break time, fruit is provided for children in Medcroft and Nethercote Classes. Other children are encouraged to bring a healthy snack consisting of fruit or vegetables.

All children in Medcroft and Nethercote Classes (Yr R, 1 and 2) are entitled to Free Universal Infant Free School Meals. Some other children are entitled to free school meals, please speak in confidence to the office if you think your child may be entitled.

School meals are available at a cost of £2.30 per day. Children may bring a healthy packed lunch from home if they prefer. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles are permitted. All children are able to refill their water bottle with fresh water during the day.

Transport – We encourage children to walk to school or travel by scooter or bicycle, wearing a helmet.

Parking - Parents are asked to park their cars in the Village Hall car park or to park responsibly in St John's Road.

Uniform – All children are expected to wear the correct school uniform including appropriate footwear during the school day and for P.E. lessons. Please help us by labelling clothes and all personal property.

Behaviour – We encourage a positive approach to behaviour based on success, praise and reward. We ask parents to contact us with any circumstances at home or school they feel may affect their child's behaviour or performance in school.

Outdoor Learning - All children have the opportunity to take part in outdoor learning. For dates, please check the school website as your child will require appropriate clothing and footwear.

Emergency Closure – In the event of severe weather or other unforeseen circumstances, it may be necessary to close the school at short notice. Please check the school website, the County Council website, or listen to local radio stations.

Absence Requests – We are unable to authorise term time holiday requests.

Collective Worship – Children take part in daily acts of worship led by a teacher, Reverend Marcus Green or a church leader from another Christian denomination.

St. Nicholas' Church – Children visit our Parish Church several times a year for a service often based around a Christian Festival. Parents and community members are invited to these services.

PTA Help us to raise money for the benefit of the children and to strengthen the relationship between families and the school.

The PTA funds both one-off and regular activities and projects, e.g. the theatre-group Christmas pantomime, Forest School and cooking equipment, books at Christmas and Easter treats. We also support regular events such as Sports Day, May Day and special days which have seen the children experience a wide variety of cultural, sporting, musical and practical activities to enhance the curriculum.
