


Around the world in 60 days

Religious Education:

Physical Education:

As sports women and sports men we will be playing hockey. We will work on passing the ball, working as part of a team, dribbling and using the space around us.

English

In English we will be studying fiction and non-fiction texts. In our fiction unit we will be focusing on Traditional Tales from the UK and other cultures. We will also have some fun learning the importance of a handwritten letter, writing to some of our favourite authors and characters using the royal mail and our magic post-box.

Supported by our topic and food technology units our non-fiction module will give us the opportunity to test out our instruction writing skills for recipes and craft making. We will also look at recounts writing about our enrichment day.

Maths

In maths we will focus on the following areas

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
 - Geometry
 - Graphs
 - Time
- Measurement
 - Fractions
 - Money

These areas are revisited many times over the course of the year.

History

We will specifically focus on the festival and celebration of Chinese New Year. We will learn about the story behind Chinese New Year, its importance and how it is celebrated. We will also look at Italy and the similarities and differences between two countries in Europe.

Geography

We will learn about the continents and oceans of our world. As well as exploring a range of maps, learning some key map skills and creating some of their own.

Science

As Scientists we will be looking at properties of materials. Learning to identify different materials and describing what the material is like. We will investigate how some materials can bend, stretch, twist and squash.

Music

As musicians we will explore beat through movement, body percussion and instruments. We will combine steady beat with word rhythms and explore changes in tempo.

Computing

In computing this term we will be learning about programming and using Bee Bots. We will also be using the I pads to make stop/motion animations.

Food Technology

In Food Technology we will be exploring foods from around our world. Discovering dishes native to other countries and comparing them to the UK.

Art

As artists we will be creating different prints using a range of materials. To link with science we will explore printing using both natural and man-made materials.

PSHE

Our theme for PSHE is **Relationships**. We will be learning about healthy relationships, feelings and emotions and valuing differences.

Enrichment

To celebrate our chef status this term we will be having a whole day dedicated to cooking. Our cookery masterclass (led by a professional) will ensure that our mini chefs take home some key cookery skills.
