House of Commons Christmas Card Competition 2018

Pupils of Tackley Primary School have been invited by Robert Courts MP, to enter the annual Christmas card competition which is open across primary schools in the Witney and West Oxfordshire ward.

The winning design will be turned into the constituency Christmas card for this year, which is sent to over 400 people, including the Prime Minister, other leading politicians and local figures.

The theme of this year's competition is '**My Favourite Christmas Tradition**'. Please see below the guidelines of the competition.

- The winner will be notified no later than Friday 2nd November 2018. The winner and runners-up will also be published on Robert Courts MP's website – www.robertcourts.co.uk .
- All entries must be around the theme of : 'My Favourite Christmas Tradition'.
- All entries must be on unfolded A4 paper.
- This competition is open to all children attending primary school in Witney and West Oxfordshire.
- Originals sadly cannot be returned.
- Entry is limited to one per child.
- By submitting an entry to the competition, participants agree that their artwork can be used as a Christmas card for the Member of Parliament for Witney, Robert Courts, and that it can be reproduced in local media and local literature, both political and Parliamentary.
- Robert Courts MP's decision regarding winning entries is final and no correspondence will be entered into disputing the result.
- The winning pupil will be invited along with their parents or guardians to have a tour of Parliament by Robert Courts MP and have refreshments.
- The first and second runners up will receive a House of Commons gift.

Entries should be brought into school **no later than 3pm on Friday 12th October** so that they can be collated and sent off ahead of the competition deadline.
