The **Winter Mini Challenge** encourages children to keep reading through the winter holidays by rewarding them for reading and reviewing **three books**

This winter we are very excited to team up with our publisher partner **Oxford Children's Books** for a special Mini Challenge inspired by Pugs of the Frozen North by the brilliant Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. The Challenge starts on **Monday 2 December 2019** and finishes on **Monday 13 January 2020**, so there's plenty of time to get involved!

Taking part online

To take part in the Winter Mini Challenge online, children simply read any three books of their choice, then rate and review them at www.winterreadingchallenge.org.uk (this URL will take you to our year-round children's website). eBooks and audiobooks count too!

Books added to the website during the six-week Mini Challenge period will count towards unlocking the special rewards: a certificate to print off and keep, and a virtual badge for the child's website profile.

The website will also feature printable activities, recommendations for great winter reads, and a pug-themed competition. For even more reading suggestions try the Book Sorter, our unique database of children's peer-to-peer recommendations. All the books it recommends have been rated and reviewed by children using the website.

We will also be having activity sheets in the library.
