
Year 2 Google Classroom Meet: Friday 15th May 2020

## **Dear Parents**

On Friday 15th May we would like to organise a Year 2 get together via Google Meet. This call won't be focussed on learning, it is an opportunity to say hello to each other and socialise. I know I am really missing all of the children, so I'm sure they're missing each other too.

I will set up a Meet for Friday at 10am, children will need to log on to Google Classroom, there are then two ways to join the Meet.

Either click the meet link below the class name in the Stream



They will both be visible before Friday but they won't work until then.

There are a few guidelines and rules for you to be aware of and please make sure your children know about them before the call:

Pupils can join the call on any smartphone, tablet, or computer with a microphone. If using ios system (iphones, ipads or imac) then you will need to have the google meets app downloaded as well as the Google Classroom app.

Google Meet records the call and saves the text chat. This is for Safeguarding purposes.

Staff, pupils and anyone else in their households must wear appropriate clothes (Friday's challenge is to be up and dressed by 10!!)

Calls must not be held in bedrooms

Language must be appropriate, just as we would expect in the classroom

Children will need to mute their microphones when they aren't talking to improve sound quality.

I thought it would be nice for everyone to share something about their experiences in lockdown so far. Each child will have some time to share, they can just talk about what they've been up to, write a diary entry or poem, show some things they have created etc.
