Year 3/4
Spring Term



Maths

As mathematicians we shall continue to explore number through multiplication and division, we will be expanding on our KS1 statistics, money, fractions and length and perimeter knowledge. Year 4 will also learn about decimals and area.

English

We will learn about Myths and Legends, stories from imaginary worlds, non-chronological reports, recounts as well as traditional and performance poetry.

Computing

This term we are going to be looking at using the computers to draw and produce art. We are also going to spend some time looking at research and communication.

Science

As scientists we will be learning about living things and their habitats and animals including humans. We will be developing our investigative skills by carrying out a range of studies that require us to set up a fair test, make observations, record results and create scientific conclusions.

Music

We are going to be looking at pulse and metre – exploring rhythm, beats in a bar (2,3 and 4) and recognizing music signatures.

Religious Education

The miracles of Jesus – could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles or is there some other explanation. Easter Forgiveness – what is good about good Friday?
