Maths

As mathematicians we shall be developing our understanding of Number: Decimals, Fractions and Percentages, Algebra. Measures: Converting Units, Perimeter, Area and Volume and Statistics.

We will continue to make use of acquired skills and knowledge to solve a variety of mathematical problems and puzzles.

English

We will learn about Fantasy Stories, Persuasion and Arguments and Narrative Poetry.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about Scratch and Developing Games and 3D Modelling.

Science

As scientists we will be learning about 'Living Things and their Habitats' including the process of reproduction and the life cycles of plants, mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. We will also learn about 'Animals Including Humans' where children will learn about the life cycle of a human being.

Music

To explore beat, rhythm and pulse.

Religious Education

Our themes this term are Trinity and Easter. We will be thinking about the key questions 'Does belief in the Trinity help Christians make better sense of God as a whole?' and 'How significant is it for Christians to believe that God intended Jesus to die?'

French

In French our topics are 'That's Tasty' and 'Family and Friends'.

Art and Design

As artists and designers we shall be studying the life and work of Kandinsky and creating our own pieces inspired by this. We will be investigating and evaluating bread products, making bread experimenting with different ingredients and evaluating.

Physical Education

PE this term will have a focus on skills and fitness through games.

History and Geography

We will learn about trends of crime and punishment from the Romans to the 21st Century.

PSHE

Our theme for PSHE is 'One World', 'Money Matters' and 'Diverse Britain'.
