## English

As writers we will begin focusing on quest stories, learning about the past and present progressive tense and writing stories about adventures. Later on in the term, we will be writing instructions and making a class recipe book to inspire us.

## Maths

As mathematicians we will be learning about position and direction, learning line dancing to help us with this! We will then move on to recap fractions before beginning time later on in the term. There will also be opportunities to revisit money, multiplication and division when we focus on problem solving skills.

## Topic

Our topic this term is 'Fire! Fire!' and it is all about the Great Fire of London! This term we will be thinking about life in London back in 1666 and how it compares to now. We will explore recipes from the time as well as building materials once used that could have contributed to the fire.

## Art, design and technology

As part of our topic, we will explore St. Paul's cathedral and make our own stained glass windows. We will then move on to explore some famous artists and imitate their work.

## Religious Education

This term we will be thinking about special days as we learn all about the Shabbat and the Jewish religion. We will consider which days are special to us and what we celebrate.

## Music

This term we are exploring tempo and rhythm. We will be learning songs and chants as well as exploring body percussion.

## Computing

This term we will be painting, learning how to use and navigate a simple paint programme. We will learn about the different tools and work towards making a poster for fire safety.

## Enrichment

This term, we will be on site for much of our enrichment. The children will have STEM, music and ARTS focused days as well as forest school for outside learning.

## Physical Education

As athletes we will be practicing our catching, kicking and throwing skills. We will work towards playing kwik cricket before progressing onto athletics.

## Guided Reading

Nethercote will begin reading 'On Sudden Hill' and practicing their 'think aloud' skills. We will then focus on vocabulary and begin reading 'The Last Wolf' and Traction Man.

## PSHE

We will learn how to keep ourselves and others safe inside and outside of the home. We will consider who our trusted people are and how we can find help if we need it, as well learning fire, water and train safety.

## Science

As Scientists we will be exploring everyday materials. We will learn about the different materials we use and a little about how they are made. The children will learn to group the materials by their properties and whether they are manmade or natural.
