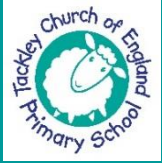


# Modern Europe Explored

## Religious Education

This term we will be finding out more about Hindu beliefs and the pilgrimage to the River Ganges.

## Physical Education

In PE we will be learning about and playing cricket.

## Maths

As mathematicians we will be developing and deepening our knowledge of measurement; time, money, mass and capacity. Statistics, shape and position and direction. We will continue to keep our maths knowledge on the boil by practising key maths skills through fluent in five.

## English

This term we will produce our own narratives, poems and non chronological reports, we will use the topics of architecture, under the sea, animal poems and stories from different cultures to do this.

## Science

As scientists we will be covering the topics of sound and electricity this term. In our sound unit we will explore vibrations, hearing sounds, higher and lower pitch, sound proofing and making music. We will also be creating our own string telephones to understand how sound changes over distance.

**In electricity we will cover everyday electrical appliances, electrical circuits, conductors and insulators and switches.**

## History and Geography

We are off exploring Europe this term with our topic Modern Europe explored. We will be learning the countries that make up Europe, looking at capital cities and discovering European landmarks.
