Maths

As mathematicians we shall be developing our understanding of Statistics: line graphs, pie charts and averages. Measures: Volume and Capacity. Shape: Angles, properties of shape and position and direction. We will continue to make use of acquired skills and knowledge to solve a variety of mathematical problems and puzzles.

English

We will learn about Reports and Recounts, Classic Plays, Historical and Modern Letters and Poems on a Theme.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about video editing.

Science

As scientists we will be learning about 'Forces' including gravity, friction, air and water resistance, floating and sinking, levers, pulleys and gears. We will also learn about 'Scientists and Inventors' where children will learn about David Attenborough, Margaret Hamilton, Eva Crane, Stephanie Kwolek and Leonardo DaVinci.

Music

This term our focus will be on singing.

Religious Education

Our themes this term are 'Beliefs and Moral Values' and 'Beliefs and Practices'. We will be thinking about the key questions 'Do beliefs in Karma, Samsara and Moksha help Hindus lead good lives?' and 'What is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God?'

French

In French our topics are 'School Life' and 'Family and Friends'.

Art and Design

As artists and designers we will be learning how to sketch and paint portraits. We will sculpt using wire mesh and Modroc and paint life like representations of Henry VIII or one of his wives.

Physical Education

PE this term will include: Maypole dancing, cricket, tennis, athletics and rounders.

History and Geography

We will learn about who the Tudors are and when they lived, Tudor clothing and food, crime and punishment, diseases and treatments and what everyday life was like for children.
