Confirmed COVID-19 positive case

We are writing to inform you that today, **Friday 20th May 2022**, we have two cases of confirmed COVID-19 in Harborne class (Year 3 and Year 4).

We remain open, and your child should continue to attend as normal if they remain well. All students and staff, regardless of year group, should remain vigilant.

What to do if your child feels unwell

If your child is unwell and has a high temperature they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19

Guidance states that if your child tests positive for COVID-19 they should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. If they no longer have a temperature they can return to school.

How to stop coronavirus (COVID-19) spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with coronavirus (COVID-19): [guidance on how to stay safe and help prevent the spread:](#)

There are simple things you can do in your daily life that will help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory infections and protect those at highest risk. Things you can choose to do are:

1. Get vaccinated.
2. Let fresh air in if meeting others indoors.
3. Practise good hygiene:
 - wash your hands
 - cover your coughs and sneezes
 - clean your surroundings frequently
4. Wear a face covering or a face mask they can help reduce the chance of you spreading infection to others, especially in crowded and enclosed spaces, and may protect you from becoming infected by some respiratory viruses.
