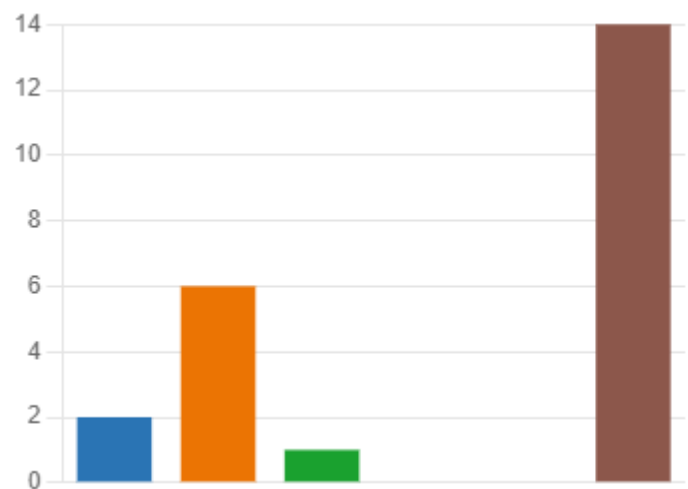

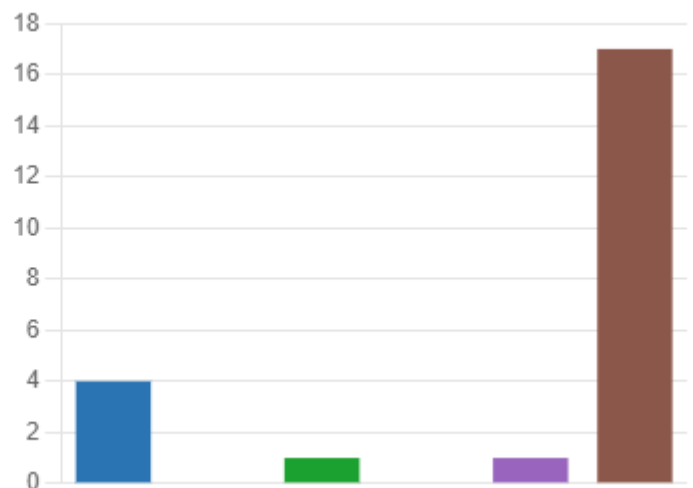
Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

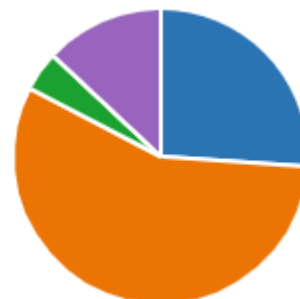

Next steps

“Tackley School lets me know how my child is doing”

- We will continue to send school reports home three times a year and offer two parents evenings a year.
- This year we are planning more whole school curriculum days, these will involve opportunities for parents to come into school to see their children’s work and books, as well as talk to their child’s class teacher.

“Tackley makes me aware of what my child will learn”

- Last year we uploaded curriculum maps to the website for each term and signposted to this in our newsletter as well as updating the class pages.
- This year we have revised our approach so parents know what their children will be learning for the whole academic year. These were shared with parents at the parents information evening, as well as being uploaded to the website. These include detailed information about what the children will learn over the year. Our curriculum information will also be updated on the website, so parents can see the progression of knowledge and skills being taught across the year groups.
- We will continue to hold reading and phonics information evenings for parents in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Other actions as a result of our parent survey

- We will revise our behaviour policy, including rewards and consequences, and consult with parents and children.
- We will try to offer a wider range of clubs and extra-curricular activities for children both after school and at lunchtimes.
